



## **Sport Pilot Certificate-Airplane**

### FAR Part 61 Requirements

1. Be at least 17 years of age.
2. Be able to read, speak and understand the English language
3. Hold a Student Pilot Certificate
4. Current and valid U.S. driver's license unless §61.303(b) applies or valid medical certificate issued under FAR part 67
5. Pass an examination on aeronautical knowledge
6. Pass an oral and practical test on maneuvers and procedures
7. Complete a minimum of 24 hours of ground instruction (may be computer based self-study)
8. Accumulate 20 hours of flight time, to include the following:
  - a. A minimum of 15 hours of flight training from a Certificated Flight Instructor
    - i. 2 hours cross country flight training
    - ii. 3 hours of preparation for the sport pilot practical test
  - b. A minimum of 5 hours of solo flight including:
    - i. At least one solo cross country

## Sport Pilot Certificate

### Cost Estimate

The following good faith estimate represents the total costs to complete the Sport Pilot Course, FAR Part 61.

This estimate is based on the following assumptions:

1. The student will be available to fly a minimum of 2 lessons per week in order to foster greater retention and course continuity.
2. Course curriculum will be closely followed.
3. Student is of average ability.

It is very possible to complete the flight portion of the FAR Part 61 Sport Pilot course in less time than stated in this estimate. However, experience has shown that these are realistic figures. In either case, you will only be charged for the actual hours flown, and actual ground instruction time spent with the instructor.
